All entries and payment to be received by Sunday 27th October 2019 at 2300hrs**

Entries fees / Registration

- **Senior crews** £8.50/seat and **Junior crews** £7.00/seat, **Mixed Junior/Senior Crews** £8.50/seat, this includes Scottish Rowing levy and charges levied by Scottish Canals. **Note: coxes are free.**
- All entry fees must be paid **before** the DRAW takes place. **There will be no payment for entries on the day.**
 - Cheques (one per club, please) made payable to Inverness Rowing Club should be sent to Hazel Geddes 7 Dores Avenue Inverness IV2 4RR, together with a signed paper copy of your Summary Page from the Entry spreadsheet.

- Registration will open at 09:00 to allow a Club Representative to collect Registration Pack, 1 pack will be issued per Club. This Pack will contain
 - Essential Information for Competitors including Bow & Back Numbers;
 - a Course Map;
 - Circulation pattern at start;
 - and any other information which should be read prior to participation
 - Bin bag – please use to clear up your litter before leaving
- Clubs will be charged £5 for each bow number that is lost or damaged and needs to be replaced.
- Clubs are reminded of their responsibility to ensure that all entrants have a valid racing licence. **Clubs must provide a summary of the racing licence information for all competitors entered** (e.g. a download of the information provided on the Scottish Rowing membership system) – this should include Name & Licence Number plus Date of Birth (for Junior and Masters entries) and be submitted when collecting their Registration Pack.
- Registration of Club Entries must be made by one Club official
- Crew Changes and Scratched Entries on the day to be notified on form included in Registration Pack.
- Refunds to Clubs will only be made if Organisers are advised prior to the Draw being made.

Racing

- All coxes/coaches/steerers must attend marshalling briefing at 9am each morning
- The event will be run in accordance with the Scottish Rowing Rules of Racing and Scottish Rowing Water Safety Code
- The short course will be run over a 3750 metre distance and the long course over a 4500 metre distance from Dochgarroch to Inverness Rowing Club
- On Saturday, the first divisions will commence at 11:15/11:30 and the second divisions will commence at 14:45/15:00.
- On Sunday, the first divisions will commence at 10:45/11:00 and the second divisions at 14:15/14:30.

Punctuality

- All short course boats must have passed the finishing line on their way to the start no later than 45 minutes before the short course start time; all long course boats must have passed the finishing line on their way to the start no later than 25 minutes before the short course start time.
- Late departures will be disqualified and turned back, in fairness to crews waiting at the start.
- Short course crews must be in position at the start 10 minutes before the start of racing. Long course crews must have passed the short course crews before the scheduled start time for the short course.
- Crews arriving late at the start will receive time penalties. 10s will be added for every minute a crew is late.

General

- Prizes shall be awarded for the fastest in each category, provided more than 2 crews are competing.
- There will be a victor ludorum competition for the club that scores the most points in the "Head of the Caledonian Canal". Points will be awarded to clubs based on participation (i.e. the number of crews/competitors entered) and performance (i.e. the speed of each crew compared to the winners of their event). Time Only and composite crews will be excluded from this competition.
- Masters events will be raced as one category. Final placings will be awarded following handicapping using the Scottish Rowing approved handicap calculation.
- The number of women in a mixed crew must be at least half the total (excluding coxes).

Facilities

- Hot drinks and refreshments will be available all day at the Boathouse.
- There are no showers at the Boathouse but the nearby Sports Centre is open to all members of the public (an entry fee is payable).
- Toilet facilities are available around the Boathouse and at various locations beside Boat Trailer parking
 - Toilets within the boathouse are for use of Umpires and regatta officials only.
- Parking of Boat Trailers will be advised on publication of the Running Order
- The Highland Rugby Club car park may not be available for parking Mini Buses and Cars this year – alternative parking arrangements will be advised on publication of the Draw.

GDPR Notice

- To run this event, Inverness Rowing Club has a Legitimate Interest in collecting the following information from competitors:
 - Name, Club, Date of Birth (for Juniors & Masters entries), Racing Licence (number and racing status)
 - Photographs & video of crews at start and finish for the purpose of checking the results of the timing system.
- This information may be shared with Scottish Rowing (to maintain compliance with the Rules of Racing) and other club officials (to resolve any dispute about crew eligibility or race results).
- Inverness will publish the stroke names, event entered, club and Masters status plus time over the course for each crew on its website to advise the running order and results.
- With the exception of the information on the running order and results, all data received will be deleted or securely destroyed 1 month after the event. The running order and results will continue to be available on our website for several years (no date has been set for its removal).
- Please contact us if you wish a crew to be redacted from the publication of the results.
- This event will take place in a public space. People may take and share photographs during the weekend. With the exception of the photographs and video we collect for processing the results, such activity is undertaken on a personal basis and Inverness Rowing Club can take no responsibility for the collection or use of such personal information.
