General information –
All entries and payment to be received by Friday 1st February 2019 at 1800hrs

Entries fees / Registration

- **Senior crews** £8.50 /seat and **Junior crews** £7.00/seat, **Mixed Junior/Senior Crews** £8.50/seat, this includes Scottish Rowing levy and charges levied by Scottish Canals. **Note: coxes are free.**
- All entry fees must be paid **before** the DRAW takes place. **There will be no payment for entries on the day.** Cheques (one per club, please) made payable to Inverness Rowing Club should be sent to Hazel Geddes 7 Doros Avenue Inverness IV2 4RR, together with a signed paper copy of your Summary Page from the Entry spreadsheet.
- Payment can also be made using BACS, E-mail feb2019@invernessrowing.club for details.
- The regatta organisers will attempt to ensure that all entries have competition and will move crews without competition to the next highest category in the same division, for example in Saturday Division 1 R1 would be moved to Open, Vet to R2 (if eligible) and J16 to R2. Please use the comments section on the entry form if you wish to make any specific requests for individual crews.
- Registration will open at 09:30 to allow a Club Representative to collect Registration Pack, 1 pack will be issued per Club. This Pack will contain
 - Bin bag – please use to clear up your litter before leaving
 - Essential Information for Competitors including Bow & Back Numbers;
 - a Course Map;
 - Circulation pattern at start;
 - Contact details for the event co-ordinator, first aiders, child protection officer and emergency services;
 - and any other information which should be read prior to participationIt is essential that these are read and understood by ALL athletes, coxes and coaches. These are for your safety and to support smooth running of the event
- There will be a deposit payable at the time of collection of £5 per Bow Number eg if there were 5 Bow Numbers then a deposit of £25 would be required – this of course will be returned when the complete pack is returned at the end of racing.
- Clubs are reminded of their responsibility to ensure that all entrants have a valid racing licence. **Clubs must provide a summary of the racing licence information for all competitors entered** (e.g. a download of the information provided on the Scottish Rowing membership system) – this should include Name & Licence Number plus Date of Birth (for Junior and Veteran entries) and be submitted when collecting their Registration Pack.
- Registration of Club Entries must be made by one Club official
- Crew Changes and Scratched Entries on the day to be notified on form included in Registration Pack.
- Refunds to Clubs will only be made if Organisers are advised prior to the final Draw being posted.

Racing

- All coxes/coaches/steerers to attend marshalling briefing at 9:30am each morning
- The event will be run in accordance with the Scottish Rowing Rules of Racing and Scottish Rowing Water Safety Code
- On Saturday, the first division will commence at 12:00 and the second division will commence at 14:30.
- On Sunday, the first division will commence at 11:30 and the second at 14:00.
- **Time Only:** Time only entries will be accepted at the discretion of the event organisers and we would encourage competitors to enter the events advertised. If anyone wishes to enter as TO please contact the organisers for a TO entry form. Time only crews will be subject to the Scottish Rowing rules of racing.
- Any crew that is disqualified will not be advised of its time.

Possible Event Control Options

This event tends to be a smaller event than our November Fours & Small Boats Head so the regatta organisers do not expect to run a short and long course as a way to manage the marshalling at the start.

However, if entry numbers are significantly greater than last year and/or if weather forecasts indicate that it is prudent to make changes then we shall review options to reduce waiting times at the start. Options that may be considered include:-

- Running the event (or some categories in each division) in the reverse direction from the boathouse to Dochgarroch (crews would be marshalled in the straight below the swing bridge);
- Launching all fours/quads/eights early, i.e. before the small boats;
- Shortening the course for the Novice and J14 events, who would start after the first corner at a point on the "Beeches Straight".

These changes may result in a slight amendment to the start time of the divisions but there will be no change to the usual launching times, i.e. in any event all crews wanting to row in Division 1 must be available to launch from 9:45 on Saturday and 9:15 on Sunday.

Student Events and Running Order

- Student crews should enter the relevant Scottish Rowing event. They will automatically be entered into the corresponding Student Event as follows
 - Open crews will be entered in the Championship event
 - R1 crews will be entered into the Intermediate event
 - R2 crews will also be entered into the Intermediate event
 - Novice crews will be entered in the Beginner event
- The event organisers will endeavour to ensure that crews in each Scottish Rowing and Scottish Student event will race in a consecutive block in the running order by
 - Keeping the student crews together in the Open category;
 - Ordering R1 and R2 events together as follows:- the non-Student R1 crews will start first, followed by the Intermediate Student crews racing in R1, then the Intermediate Student Crews racing in R2 and finally the non-Student R2 crews.

- The following eligibility criteria apply to Student Event entries
 - Open - any sculler/crew may enter
 - Intermediate - sculler/crew of R1 status or below
 - Beginner - sculler/crew learned to scull/row in current academic year
 - Cox - male 55kg, female 50kg
 - A second entry can only be made in an Intermediate event if an entry is made in the equivalent Championship event. There is no limit on the number of entries that can be made in any event subject to this restriction.
 - All students eligible under Scottish Student Sport rules are invited to enter provided their university or college is affiliated to Scottish Student Sport.
 - A Scottish Rowing licence must be held by all competitors

Punctuality

- All boats must have passed the finishing line on their way to the start no later than 30 minutes before the start time.
- Late departures will be turned back, in fairness to crews waiting at the start.
- Crews must be in position at the start 10 minutes before the start of racing.
- Crews arriving late at the start will receive time penalties.

General

- Prizes shall be awarded for the fastest in each category, provided more than 3 or more crews have entered.
- Veteran events will be raced as one category. Final placings will be awarded following handicapping using the Scottish Rowing approved handicap calculation.
- Mixed events shall comprise an equal number of men and women (but in accordance with Scottish Rules of Racing a woman can count as a man in this calculation).

Facilities

- Hot drinks and refreshments will be available all day at the Boathouse.
- There are no showers at our Boathouse, however the nearby Sports Centre is open to all Members of the Public. An entry fee is payable.
- Toilet facilities available at the Boathouse and at various locations beside Boat Trailer parking
- Parking of Boat Trailers will be advised on publication of the Draw

GDPR Notice

- To run this event, Inverness Rowing Club has a Legitimate Interest in collecting the following information from competitors:
 - Name, Club, Date of Birth (for Juniors & Veteran entries), Racing Licence (number and racing status)
 - Photographs & video of crews at start and finish for the purpose of checking the results of the timing system.
- This information may be shared with Scottish Rowing (to maintain compliance with the Rules of Racing) and other club officials (to resolve any dispute about crew eligibility or race results).

- Inverness will publish the stroke names, event entered, club and Veteran status plus time over the course for each crew on its website to advise the running order and results.
- With the exception of the information on the running order and results, all data received will be deleted or securely destroyed 1 month after the event. The running order and results will continue to be available on our website for several years (no date has been set for its removal).
- Please contact us if you wish a crew to be redacted from the publication of the results.
- This event will take place in a public space. People may take and share photographs during the weekend. With the exception of the photographs and video we collect for processing the results, such activity is undertaken on a personal basis and Inverness Rowing Club can take no responsibility for the collection or use of such personal information.
